east one thousand two hundred and seventy perches to a post
then by vacant land south south east sixty two perch^s to a
post then by the line of Mounse Justice's land south 20 deg^s
west one thousand and three hundred perches to a post by
Schuylkill-then up the same to the Beginning. by D. Powel
