

By virtue of a warrant from the Prop^r & Gov^r dated the 21st day of 8^{ber} 1701 for laying out ten thousand acres of land to Andreas Rudman and several of the Swedes. Surveyed and laid out the 28th day of the fifth month 1704. unto Richard Roads three hundred acres of land (part of the said ten thousand acres) Situate on the east side of Schuylkil in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a post by the by the river Schuylkil at the corner of Otto Ernest Cook's land then by the same north twenty degrees east one thousand one hundred and eighty perches to a post then by vacant land east south east forty perches and a half to a post Then by the line of Matthias Natcelins's land south twenty degrees ~~east~~ west one thousand and two hundred perches to Schuylkil River. Then up the same on the courses thereof to the beginning
