a Lott in ye City proportionable to his Purchase of six hundred &
fifty Acres. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or
cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in any of ye Streets sett out
for Purchasers of ye like quantity he fencing it in & building upon
ye same according to regulation, & make returns thereof into my
Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y^e 17th of y^e 4th m^e 1684.
