vania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be  
survey'd & lay'd out a Town above Jasper Farmer joyning unto his  
Land half a mile fronting each side of Skullhill, & going back a  
mile & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 3<sup>d</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1683.
