



This Tract surveyed to Yourey Bess in behalf of William Allon, Beginning at a marked hickrey standing by the side of the West Branch of Dalawar then southeast thirty perches to a heap of stons then northeast twenty-two perches to a black oak, then southeast fourty four perches to a whit-oak by va-cand land then northeast an hundred and sixty perches to a post then northwest twenty perches to a post then north northeast two hundred and sixty-four perches by vacand land to a heap of stons then northwest fourty perches to a linden tree by the side of the west branch of Dalawar then upp the several corses of the sain to the place of beginning containing two hundred and thirteen acres surveyed in the year 1736
