At the request of Edward Roberts of the City of Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up within the said City the Lott of Ground appurtenant to Two hundred & fifty acres of land purchased of the Propriet^r by Thomas Bayly of Bristol in Great Britain by Deeds of Lease and Release dated ye 26th & 27th dayes of September Anno 1681 who by like Deeds dated ye 8th & 9th days of the month called May 1713. Granted & conveyd the same unto the said Edward Roberts and also that he might take up the proportion of Liberty Land belonging to the same. These are to authorize and require thee to survey & lay out or cause to be survey'd and laid out unto the said Edward Roberts in the said City the said Lott of Ground which falls on Schuylkil side and the Liberty Land in the Liberties of the said City in proportion of the said purchased Land and make Returns of the whole into the Secretary's Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and seal of the Province at Philad^a the 4th day of ye first moth Anno Din 171 $\frac{3}{4}$.
