


FORM No. 1.



By vertue of a warrant from the Courte at Kingses bearing  
date the 13<sup>th</sup> of the 8<sup>th</sup> mo. 1680. Layd out for John Mifflin Sen<sup>r</sup> & Jun<sup>r</sup>  
a tract of land called Topps situated & being on the west side of Dell-  
aware River & on the East side of the Scoolekill beginnabl. at a cor-  
ner marked Hickery of ye 10bd of ob<sup>r</sup> ob. called Edgerly Point)  
standing by sd Greek and from thence N.E.b.E. by Wm Orins line of marked  
trees 330 perches to a corner marked white oak from thence S.E.b.S.  
by Wm Claytons line of marked trees 150 perches to a corner marked  
red oak standing neare sd Claytons line and from thence S.W. by W.  
by a line of marked <sup>trees</sup> 12 perches to a corner marked black oak standing  
by the <sup>side</sup> ~~width~~ of Scoolekill from thence up by sd Greek 140 perches  
to the first menoblioned hickery containing 300 acres of land Surveyd  
the 23<sup>d</sup> of 3<sup>d</sup> mo. 1681.
