


Pensilvania }



William Penn Absolute Proprietary and Govern<sup>t</sup> in  
Chief of the Province of Pensilvania and Counties annexed.

These are to require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be  
survey'd unto John Nelson purchaser of five hundred acres a  
Lott in the second street from the River Delaware in the City of  
Philadelphia adjoyning to the next Lott to Hugh Derborow's on  
the North Side thereof and make Returns into my Secretaries  
office. Given under my Hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 22<sup>d</sup>  
of the twelfth month 1709—
