Cook each a hundred, to David Kinsey three hundred, to David James two hundred, to Sam. Miles three hundred, to Rich. <sup>to Tho. Jones 250<sup>a</sup> in the County of Philadelphia</sup> Miles & Peter Edwards each a hundred in a place not taken up and according to the method of townshippes.

I hereby authorize thee to survey and set out unto them, their respective quantities in the second townshipp back at Darby townshipp onely observe to lay out in the begining of this second townshipp fifty acres which was overplus of 6000<sup>a</sup> in the first townshipp and make me a returne of the original field work & protracted figure, which are to remain on record in my office. Philadelphia 18<sup>th</sup> 5-mo. 1683.
