quire thee fforthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto
him ye said number of acres in ye aforesaid County where
not already taken up according to ye method of townshipp^s
appaynted by ye Gover^r he seating and improveing ye same
within six months after ye date of survey and make returne
hereoff to the Secretarys office dated at Philadelphia ye
6th of 10th mo. 1686.
