Whereas 'tis affirmed to us that Colonel ffrederic Redegeldt hath lately purchased of the Proprieabl. ten thousand acres of land in this Province of which he granted to ~~one hundred~~ Lawrence Christopher Nohren two hundred and fifty acres part thereof to be laid out in the said Province between the Rivers Delaware and Sasquehannagh which the said Lawrence hath requested of us that he may take up. These are to authorize thee to survey and lay out in part of the purchase aforesd to the sd Lawrence Christopher Nohren (to be held by him in case the said Redegeldt purchase shall really appear to have been made) the said quantity of two hundred and fifty acres of land as aforesd (according to the method of townships appointed) that has not been already survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians and make returns into the general Surveyors office at Philad'l'a where this warrt is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary.
