Sturges Secut in the 1st Regiment and Regiment of
Foot am held and ~~is~~ bound unto Mr. Alexander
Gover of the City of Philadelphia Secut in the
Sum of three thousand & 200 Dollars lawful Money
of the Common Wealth of Pennsylvania to be paid
to the said Alexander Gover his certain Attorney
Executors Administrators or assigns to which payment
will and lawfully be made so and my self Henry
Sturges Executors and Administrator firmly by these
presents sealed with my seal dated the
day of November one thousand seven hundred
and eighty three.

~~The Execution of the~~ Stipulation made

That whereas the above bounden Henry Sturges hath
during and to him surviving Sum of Money and other
Beneficials from the United States for services performed
in the War of 1812 and whereas the said
Henry Sturges for the consideration of the Sum of thirty
thousand and five hundred by the said Alexander Gover
with great bargain sold and made over unto the
Alexander Gover his heirs and assigns the one equal
third part of all the Arrearages of pay had pay or
to be paid of half pay (lands) and all other
Beneficials whatsoever which may now or
hereafter be found due to him upon the Account
either from the United States or the State of
