

Whereas the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania granted unto William Hopkins in consideration of his services as a Soldier in the Revolutionary Army, a Patent for a Tract of Land in the 10th. Donation District numbered 2091, & containing 200 acres, which Patent & Tract of Land was by said William Hopkins conveyed to Laughlin McLean, and by said McLean & wife conveyed to the undersigned Oliver Ormsby & Isaac Gregg

and whereas the said Commonwealth gave Public notice that the said Patent contained Land lying without the boundaries of the State of Pennsylvania, therefore required the said Patent to be returned to the office in lieu of which a Patent should issue for a like quantity of unappropriated Land.

Now therefore know all Men by these presents that we the undersigned, in consideration of other 200 acres of Land to be granted as above, do hereby convey to the said Commonwealth all our rights, title & interest to said Tract of Land in the 10th. District No. 2091 and by these presents do hereby Release & forever quit claim to said Tract of Land, and which is by these presents to all intents & purposes made null & void.
