Know all men by these presents that I John Hamilton late a Soldier in the third Pennsylvania Regiment in the service of the United States of America for value and the full consideration money to me in hand paid at, and before the Execution hereof by Ebenezer Hogg of Hampshire in the County of Washington & State of New Hampshire Schoolmaster, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have, and hereby do grant, Bargain, Sell, Transfer, convey and Confirm unto the said Ebenezer Hogg his heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns forever, all the right title and interest whatsoever in Law and Equity, which I now have or which any heirs, Executors, or Administrators may hereafter have, to the Lands, pay Depreciation (to the said Ebenezer Hogg his heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns) towards the said Ebenezer Hogg's bounty Gratuity, prize money, and every other Arrearage claim and demand whatsoever due and owing me from and by the United States or any particular State, and I do hereby for myself my heirs Executors and Administrators covenant and agree, to and with the said Ebenezer Hogg his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns that if my heirs Executors Administrators will at any time hereafter at the reasonable cost & charges of the said Ebenezer Hogg his heirs, Executors Administrators or Assigns make or cause to be made any future conveyances and assurances in the Law necessary to be done for the further satisfying and confirming all and singular the premises & claims hereby granted, and assigned or intended to be, and as make contracts and appoint the said Ebenezer Hogg to be, true and lawful Attorney, irrevocable to demand and receive his for and recover from the United States or any particular State or any person or persons acting by or under their or either of their Authority all and singular the premises aforesaid claims and Involvements herein above recited and sold & now with held and retained from me the said John Hamilton with power also to Morry or Assigns for that purpose to make and substitute, and to do all lawful acts requisite for effecting the premises hereby ratifying & confirming all that my said Morry or his Substitutes or Substitutes shall do thereunto averted hereof in the said Ebenezer Hogg's name to wit any bond and seal this said Ebenezer Hogg's day of the month of March 1792 signed sealed & delivered in the presence of me the said John Hamilton one of the Justices of the Peace for the County of Philadelphia in the City of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania and I do hereby certify that the said Ebenezer Hogg is a true and correct copy of the original instrument of transfer of land in the name of the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and that the said original instrument of transfer of land in the name of the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is a true and correct copy of the original instrument of transfer of land in the name of the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
