

(12) Strasburg June 19th 1794

I wrote you some time ago respecting land which
my husband John M. Clure who served in your
Regiment during the war with Britain is entitled to

in the business, if not I hope you will endeavor to

obtain I will thank you to let me know whether you
think it could be sold in Philad^a and on what terms
being a poor Woman I must depend on some person to
do the business for me, therefore relying on your goodness
