Power of Attorney and that he knows him to be the same
and identical person who lived in the said City, that
he was present and did see the said McComb sign
said and deliver and acknowledge the same as his
Act and Deed, and that the Defendant did also see
William Hepple sign the same as a witness and that the
Defendant thereunto signed as a witness in his own hand
writing. This defendant doth also further depose that he
heard the said John McComb say there was considerable
reason of pay due to him for his services in the said
City and that he had never received his final bill
money although he had given to the end of the War and
was honorably discharged that he was a poor man and
lived near Chester in the State of New Jersey

Regiment in the United States Services for a full and valuable consideration to me in hand
well and truly paid by **James Humphrest** of the City of
Philadelphia before the sealing and delivery hereof; the receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge, have and by these presents do grant, bargain sell assign re-
lease and confirm unto the said **James Humphrest**
and to his heirs and assigns forever all my estate, right, title interest use possession
property, claim and demand whatsoever, which I now have to all and singular the
lands, pay, arrearages of pay, cloathing, rations, gratuities, or other demands due
and owing to me from the United States, or from any particular State for my
services as aforesaid; **I DO HAVE AND DO HOLD** all and singular the a-
bove mentioned and assigned premises with the appurtenancies unto him the said
James Humphrest his heirs and assigns for ever and do here-
by nominate, constitute, and appoint him the said **James Humphrest**
his heirs and assigns my true and lawful Attorney irrevocable, to ask, de-
mand, recover and receive of and from the United States, or from any particular
State, or from any person or persons acting by from or under their or any of their
authority, all and singular the said lands, pay, arrearages of pay, rations, gratuities
and other demands whatsoever due and owing to me as aforesaid, and to re-
ceive and accept the same by grant or otherwise in his or their own name or names
and to his or their own proper use and behoof forever, and also to sign seal and
execute good and sufficient discharges for the same in due form of Law.
In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal, the 26
Day of **March** in the Year of our Lord Seventeen Hundred
and Ninety four.
