demand receive and receipt for a Patent from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
for a Tract of Donation Land in the 7th District No. 1350. or for any other Tracts
of Land which ~~where~~ may or has been drawn for me as the Widow of the said
Mark M. Cord deceased Giving and Granting unto my said attorney by these presents
my full and whole power Strength and Authority in and about the Premises
hereby ratifying allowing and holding for firm and Effectual all and whatsoever my
said attorney shall lawfully do in and about the Premises by Virtue hereof
Witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed and set my Hand and Seal the first
day of October Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and ninety five 1795.
