Regiment Detaching for the Consideration of £37.10
Pounds lawful Money unto one paid by Mr.
Alexander Power have granted bargained sold
releas'd and assign'd over unto him the said Alexander
Power all the Lands which I now am, or may
be entitled to as an Officer aforesaid from the State
of Pennsylvania or United States. To hold to him
the said Alexander Power his Heirs and
Assigns for ever In Witness whereof I
have hereunto put my Hand & Seal the
fourteenth day of March 1785
