 States or the State of Pennsylvania or any other Person or Persons Acting under their Au-
 thority; and I also give and grant unto my said Attorney full Power and Absolute Autho-
 rity to sell and Dispose of all and singular the Lands Tenements Gratuities and Con-
 ceptions Which I may be Entitled to or of Right may Claim in Virtue of an Act of
 the United States in Congress Assembled or under the Authority of any of any
 Act Pennsylvania for or by Reason of my having served in the said Captains Davises
 Company Colonel Madlers Regiment and by good and sufficient Assurances in the
 Law to Grant Convey and Confirm to the Purchaser or Purchasers the Fee Simple and
 Inheritance thereof hereby granting unto my said Attorney full Power and Authority
 to Appoint one or more Attorneys under Power of Attorney for the Purpose aforesaid
 Statifying and Confirming all and singular whatsoever my said Attorneys shall
 or may do in the Premises by Virtue Whereof In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
 Set my hand and seal this Twentieth day of December in the
 Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety One
