N^o 2. N^o 3. of them in the name of John Glanville late Soldier in the Pennsylvania Line and the said John Glanville by Deed Poll bearing date the eighth day of January last did convey the same to the said Edward Harper and to his heirs and assigns forever: N^o 1. other in the name of Richard Ennis late Soldier in the Pennsylvania Line and the said Richard Ennis by Deed Poll under his hand and seal bearing date the eleventh day of October last past did convey the same to the said Edward Harper and to his heirs and assigns forever: N^o 3. other of them in the name of William
