This Indenture Made and  
concluded the Twenty first day of November  
Anno Domini 1786 Between Ternon Rock  
of the one Part And Francis Murray of  
the County of Bucks in the state of Pennyl.  
named Esquire of the other Part Witneseth  
that the said Ternon Rock in Consideration  
of the sum of Thirty seven Pounds ten Shillings  
to him in hand paid by the said Francis  
Murray and for other valuable Considerations  
deth by these presents grant, bargain and  
sell, to lease and Confirme unto the said  
Francis Murray his Heirs and Assigns for  
ever Oberlawn Tract of land in one of  
the Donahow Districts in the County of  
Westmoreland containing Two Hundred  
Fifty Acres and Allowance of Sixty Cent for Taxes  
In District N<sup>o</sup> 4 and Lot N<sup>o</sup> 9 and  
I do desire that the Patent may issue in the  
Name and as the property of said Francis  
Murray his Heirs and Assigns for ever and  
I do by these presents warrant and defend  
the said Two Hundred Acres of Land &c from  
me my Heirs and Assigns for ever all and  
every other person and persons whatsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim by from or  
under me him them or any of them. I the witness  
whereof have hereunto set my Hand and seal  
the day and year above written.
