rants granted and to be granted for surveying to me ~~Philip Stout~~ of the United States of
Land from the United States, and also ~~two hundred~~ acres, from the date of

the bennies of Lands, due to the Army of the United States, and the State of ~~Pennsylvania~~
all the Lands surveyed in pursuance thereof unto the said ~~Philip Stout~~

reages of Pay due to me as a Soldier aforesaid, from the United States or the State of ~~Pennsylvania~~
and to give receipt or receipts, for the same, and to do all lawful acts and things, necessary for effecting the
same as fully and absolutely to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do, were I personally present, at
