vey and confirm unto Frederick Molneux his heirs, executors,
administrators, and assigns for ever, all the right, title and interest whatsoever, in law and equity,
which I now have, or which my heirs, executors, or administrators, may hereafter have
to the lands,

[Redacted] due and owing [Redacted] from and by the United States or
any particular state, and do hereby for myself my heirs, executors and administrators cove-
nant and agree, to and with the said Frederick Molneux his heirs,
executors, administrators and assigns that my heirs, executors, and administrators, will, at any
time hereafter at the reasonable cost and charges of the said Frederick Molneux his
heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, make, or cause to be made, any future conveyances and assur-
ances in the law, necessary to be done, for the further transferring and confirming, all and singular the
premises and claims hereby granted and assigned, or intended so to be. And do make constitute and ap-
point the said Frederick Molneux my true and lawful attorney; irrevocable to demand and receive sue for, and recover from the United States,
or any particular State, or any person or persons, acting, by or under their or either of their authority,
all and singular the premises, rights, claims, and emoluments herein above recited and sold, and now
withheld and detained from [Redacted] the United States or the states of
Pennsylvania or either of any of them —
with power, also attorney or attorneys for that purpose, to make and substitute, and to do all lawful acts
requisite for effecting the premises, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney or
his substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.
