I do Certify that Stephen Archer has served in the British Army in Captain John Boyd's Company of Pennsylvania Rangers from the twentieth day of May 1782 to the thirtieth Day of June 1783 both Dates included and is honorably Discharged according to the Order of Council, as by the Copy hereof given under my Hand and Seal this 17th day of January 1796

I do sign over all my Right Claim or demand of my Share of the Donation Land as a Soldier in Captain John Boyd's Company of Pennsylvania Rangers as I am intitled to according to Law being Legally Discharged by Richard Johnson my Commanding Officer to Mich<sup>l</sup> Murphy his certain Attorney heirs or Assigns as given under my hand & Seal this twenty ninth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety six
