 authority, in and about the premises, to give, receive, take all
 lawful ways and means, in my name for the recovery thereof, and
 upon the receipt of any such debts, dues or any other thing or things
 acquittances or other discharges, for me and in my name to make,
 speak and deliver all and every other Oath and Oaths in the law whatso-
 ever, necessary to be done in and about the premises as fully, largely
 and amply, to all intents and purposes, as if might or could do
 if I was personally present; and do also empower my said
 Attorney by these presents, to make one or more substitutes under
 him, for the purposes above mentioned.
