

of the said Commonwealth,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:



Now ye, That in consideration of the services rendered by John Jordan <sup>in the late Army of the United States</sup> ~~in the late Army of the United States~~ — there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto the said John Jordan a certain tract of land 162.351612  
situate in Conillion, disthuct 112 in Butler County. Beginning at a black Oak thence by lot 118.2.3. West, to  
a sycamore bush at a black oak, thence by 118.2.3. South one hundred forty paces to a white Thorn, thence by 118.2.3. East to  
a sycamore bush at a black oak, and thence by 118.2.3. South one hundred thirty paces to the Beginning. Containing a hundre  
and four acres of land for roads &c. which said tract were surveyed in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly passed  
January 1785.

To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said John Jordan and his Heirs to the issue of him the said John Jordan and his Heirs for ever.

free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to Mines, Royalties, Quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part  
Silver Ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the Pitt's mouth, clear of all charges. In Testimony whereof, I have set my Hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be  
Presented, at Philadelphia this twenty-first day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six and of the Commonwealth the twenty-first.
