

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Now ye, That in consideration of the services rendered by Elias Williams Sergeant in the late Army of the United States there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto Joseph Asheton Grantee of the said Elias Williams a certain tract or parcel of land formerly in the county of Westmoreland, situate in Donation District Number two beginning at an Ash, thence by ...

To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Joseph Asheton his Heirs and Assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph Asheton his Heirs and Assigns forever

free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to Mines, Royalties, Quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all Gold and Silver Ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth, clear of all charges. In Testimony whereof, I have set my Hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed to these Presents, at Lancaster this second day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and of the Commonwealth the twenty-seventh
