his servant till her age of twenty eight years -

of November A.D. 1807, Joshua Johnson above
named came personally before me the Judge of the
Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions in and
for said County, and being duly sworn doth
depose and say that the facts in his above entry
stated, are true to the best of his knowledge
