The SPA has chapters across the state, with enthusiastic and experienced professional and avocational members who can help you with a tabletop program, and PAC has individual members, all of whom are professional archaeologists, in every part of Pennsylvania. You should contact both organizations, and they in turn can put you in touch with chapters and/or members in your local area.
