GENERAL COMMENTS

It will be noted that this application was received after the October 1 deadline. Other requests for financial assistance received from the local governmental units of Delaware County prior to the deadline appear to be worthy and are sufficient to exhaust the County's allocation (see summary report for Delaware County). Thus, this project, while probably desirable, is not eligible for a grant if the Commission's rule regarding the deadline is observed. No comprehensive analysis of the project was made since the work described by this application does not seem to be any more necessary or important than those received prior to October 1. Therefore, it is recommended that the Post-War Planning Commission deny this request for financial assistance. However, if and when an additional appropriation is made by the General Assembly or if any of the proffered grants are not accepted, it is recommended that this application be reconsidered with the view of taking favorable action thereon.

It may be suggested to the applicant that, if the proposed work involves a sewage treatment plant or appurtenances thereto, the possibility of obtaining a grant from the Sanitary Water Board of the Pennsylvania Department of Health be investigated.
